FINISHING & MAINTENANCE

Although cedar is naturally durable, a surface coat is recommended to protect the wood and extend its service life.

- Western Red Cedar accepts a wide range of stains and coatings.
- ► For best results coat all six sides before installation.
- Factory finishing is recommended and available in most market areas.
- Allow product to acclimatize to the environment where it will be installed to avoid unwanted shrinkage or expansion.
- Fasteners with corrosion resistance should be used. Hot-dipped galvanized or stainless steel.
- New cedar siding and trim should be protected from the weather before finishing. It is seldom necessary to carry out extensive surface preparation providing the wood has not weathered for more than two weeks and is clean and dry.
- Maintain your siding by keeping it free of dirt and debris.
- Important Note: Never power-wash cedar siding because it damages the wood fibres.
